WHITE CHEDDAR MACARONI & CHEESE

2 CUPS WHOLE MILK
3 CUPS SHREDDED WHITE CHEDDAR CHEESE
2 CUPS MEDIUM PASTA SHELLS
(MEASURED & UNCOOKED)
4 TBLS. OF SALTED BUTTER (1/2 STICK)
1/4 CUP OF ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR
1 TSP. GARLIC (OPTIONAL)
1/2 TSP. SALT
1/4 PEPPER

Fresh black pepper (For Garnish – Optional)

Cook pasta according to package instructions, drain, and set aside Place empty pot back on the stove, and melt butter on low heat Whisk flour, garlic powder, salt and pepper. Cook on low heat until smooth and bubbly, about 1-2 minutes (continuing to whisk so you don't get lumps)

Turn the heat to medium and whisk in the milk

Whisk continuously for 3-5 minutes on medium-high heat until the mixture bubbles and the sauce thickens.

Turn off the heat, add the shredded white cheddar cheese, and stir until melted. Place the drained pasta shells back into the cheese sauce.
